Many of the Florida GRC Reports have been indexed and are searchable using the index on the DAR website.

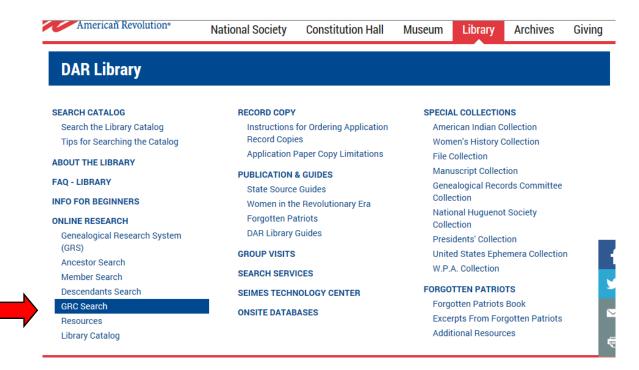
How to Search the GRC Index

⇒elect LIBRARY tab on the menu below the top menu



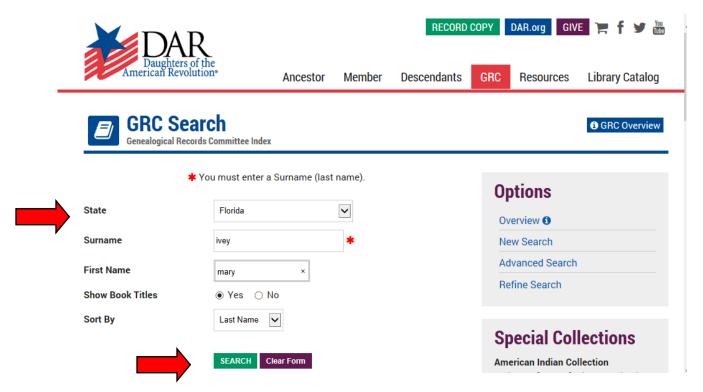
\$elect GRC SEARCH in left column



⇒Select STATE or ALL STATES AND COUNTRIES in top Search field.

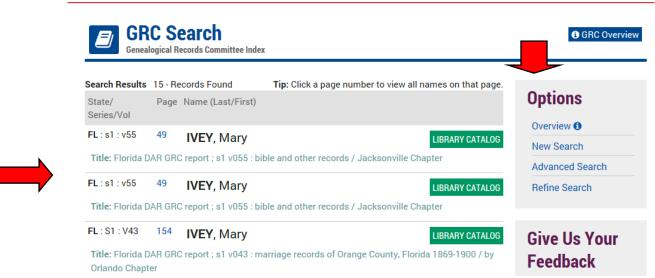
⇒nput Surname and First name in the fields provided and click SEARCH.

REMINDER: The Orlando Public Library collection only includes Florida DAR GRC records.



In the example above, we searched Florida GRC records for Mary Ivey.

The results below indicate the series, volume, and page number where the information can be found.



Check the *Master table of contents and index of Florida GRC series 1 and series 2 through volume 205* (DAR GRC Series 2, Volume 206 at DAR 975.9 FLO) to determine if the library owns the volume needed or search the catalog at www.ocls.info. Do a TITLE search with the exact term: FLORIDA DAR GRC SERIES 1 or FLORIDA DAR GRC SERIES 2. Do not include the volume number as the search sometimes does not find the item. All of the titles in the series will appear in the results in numerical order.

If the library does not have the volume needed, copies can be ordered from the DAR Library Search Service.

NOTE: The page number listed does not always match the page number in the actual volume. Check the index in the volume if information on your ancestor is not on the page listed in the online index.
